EMBROIDERY RETREAT

Goldwork Embroidery Workshop | 3 Lansell Rd, Toorak 3146

Sat/Sun 25/26 May 2019 | 9.00 am – 4.00pm

Our first retreat will be held in the gracious surrounds of "Umina", a beautiful house in Toorak Melbourne.

It will be a weekend full of stitching, with our expert, Sue Gass, who regularly teaches at the Embroiderers Guild, Victoria. Sue will show you the basics of Goldwork Embroidery.

Class size : Maximum 12 participants.

Gold work is a metal thread embroidery worked in gold threads of varying types to add depth and texture to the work. The embroidery sits on the surface of the background fabric with a waxed thread used to couch the work to the background fabric to give a 3D effect.

Participants will work a piece that they can use as a book cover, picture etc.

The piece participants will stitch is of Australian gum leaves, using various threads such as purls, couching, checks, kid etc. all requirement for the embroidery including a hoop will be provided in kit form along with extensive notes enabling students to complete the work.

Retreat cost: \$495.00

This cost includes:

1 night's accommodation at Umina B/B, single room. There are twin shares available too.

2 lunches, 1 dinner, morning and afternoon teas catered for by renowned CWA cooks.

A kit providing everything you need to complete your embroidery. However, please bring some embroidery scissors.

Please advise if you have any food allergies.

Deposit of \$200 to secure your place and the balance by May 15th.
